The presentation will include a fascinating study of this relatively unknown artist, although Johann Ruffinatscha (1812-1893) is probably Tyrol's most significant composer of the 19th century and is considered to be the link between Schubert and Bruckner by many music historians.

The research of Ruffinatscha, why he was considered important during his lifetime, his resurface, and his works and musical styles will be presented and excerpts of his compositions will be performed on the piano by the presenter.

Paul-André Bempéchat, a renowned historian and pianist has received a Research Award from the Austro-American Association to explore this composer and his works.
