interpreting her own humorous poems in Austrian Dialect.

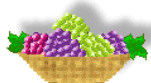
The Tuck's Point Chowder House

## TUCK'S POINT CHOWDER HOUSE

### DIRECTIONS

Take Route 128N, (passing Danvers and Beverly)  
to the first Manchester exit #16 (Pine Street).

At the end of the ramp, take a left and follow Pine Street to the end.  
Take a right onto Route 127 (Bridge Street) and follow that for less than 1 mile.

At the "Old Corner Inn", take a left onto Harbor Street.

Follow to the end (you will go over a railroad bridge).

Take a left onto Tuck's Point Road and follow to the end.  
The Chowder House is the building on the circle to the right.
