***Directions to the
Meeting House of the
Battle Road Farm Community, Lincoln, MA***

**From Route 128 (I-95), take Exit 30B to Route 2A West
(Hanscom Field/Concord).**

Go west on Route 2A for 1.5 miles to a blinking light.

Turn right (sign: Hanscom Field).

Go 0.5 miles, take a left at the fork (sign "Civil Air Field").

Go 0.2 miles straight to Old Bedford Road (you will pass a stop sign).

Take a left on Old Bedford Road.

Go 0.1 miles, passing the sign "Battle Road Farm Community".

Keep going to the next entrance left, which is a business complex Nr. "55".

**Stay to the left as you enter it, and circle around the business building until
you get to the parking lot. Park. You will see a chained gate on your left.**

Walk around it toward the Meeting House on your left.

(Look for Austrian signs to guide you.)
