Die Fälscher (A, 2007, Subtitles)

The film won the Oscar for the best foreign film in 2008. The Counterfeiters is the true story of the largest counterfeiting operation in history, set up by the Nazis in 1936. Salomon "Sally" Sorowitsch is the king of counterfeiters. He lives a mischievous life of cards, booze, and women in Berlin during the Nazi-era. Suddenly his luck runs dry when arrested by Superintendent Friedrich Herzog. Immediately thrown into the Mauthausen concentration camp, Salomon exhibits exceptional skills there and is soon transferred to the upgraded camp of Sachsenhausen. Hand-picked for his unique skill, Salomon and a group of professionals are forced to produce fake foreign currency under the program Operation Bernhard. Faced with a moral dilemma, Salomon must decide whether his actions, which could prolong the war and risk the lives of fellow prisoners, are ultimately the right ones



Other options:

Silentium (2004, No subtitles)

Based on a novel by Wolf Haas. Silentium is a fast-paced murder mystery-comedy based on a novel by Wolf Haas. A suicide turns to a murder investigation when a woman (Maria Köstlinger) hires an off-beat private investigator (Josef Hader) to find the murderer of her husband. Her husband had recently accused a Catholic boarding school director of sexual misconduct against him and others during their youth while attending the school. With his sidekick Berti (Simon Schwarz), they go behind the scenes of the Salzburg festival and into the depths of the religious school to find out what really happened.

Or: Sissi (1955, No subtitles)

How to find us:

From Route 128, take exit 16B (Westwood/Route 109). Follow Route 109 South for about 8 miles until Brook Street in Medfield. Turn right onto Brook and right again at the end onto Green Street. #92 is 1/2 mile up the street on your left (a yellow house with columns on the front porch). (25 min)
