
Theatre A - Der Onkel aus Amerika

German film luminary Hans Moser plays the title role in Der Onkel aus Amerika. Moser is cast as a bombastic Texan who throws his German nephew's household into a tizzy. Since it is assumed that every Texan is a millionaire, Moser's relatives fall over themselves to curry favor with their "wealthy" Uncle. Alas, the gentleman from Texas doesn't have a penny to his name. Even so, just the thought that prosperity is just around the corner prompts Moser's family into rediscovering their own moneymaking potential -- and enriching themselves in the process. Der Onkel aus Amerika is a remake of a 1931 German comedy, also directed by Carl Boese.



Theatre 2 - Replay

Austria, 1995 – German, English subtitles

For those not as comfortable with the German language, I found a more recent Austrian movie with English subtitles that we will show at the same time.

Robert teaches music in high school and is a somewhat ineffectual character. No one considers him capable of much. Robert has a high-school friend, Roland (Lukas Resetarits), who has become a successful popular musician despite being fairly untalented. Robert and his wife decide to go to one of Roland's concerts. When Robert gets invited by the celebrity to a post-concert bash, he begins to seem less like a loser, which causes him all kinds of trouble.

How to find us:

From Route 128, take exit 16B (Westwood/Route 109). Follow Route 109 South for about 8 miles until Brook Street in Medfield. Turn right onto Brook and right again at the end onto Green Street. #92 is 1/2 mile up the street on your left (a yellow house with columns on the front porch). (25 min)

Route 27 also takes you to Medfield from Natick/Sherborn or Routes 1 and 95 in Walpole (see map).
