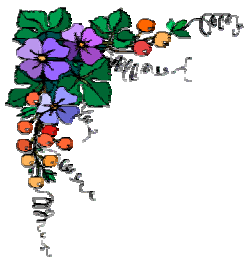

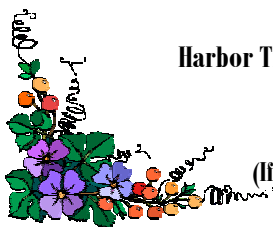
We would like to propose the following arrangements for the 14th and request
